

## PULLMAN HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Pullman High School offers a comprehensive Activities Program providing the opportunity for a balanced educational experience. It consists of four distinct groups in which students may choose to be a participant. Those groups are interscholastic athletics, competitive activities, non-competitive activities, and vocational activities.

### INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS

The Interscholastic athletic program consists of fourteen sports offerings. Various levels of competition based on grade, gender, number of participants, and ability level are offered in each sport. Programs must be sanctioned by the Washington Interscholastic Athletic Association. The chart below identifies the sport, number of participants by gender and number of teams.
